Roads and Traffic

There are several traffic black spots in Terenure which we have been working on in recent years with limited success.

The reinstatement of the right turn from Templeogue Rd on to Springfield.

After extensive correspondence between ourselves and Sth.Dublin C.C.they are not agreeable to reinstate the righthand turn...we have mobilised support of local Cllr's & TD's to have decision reversed.

Traffic situation at Rathdown/R/Farnham junction. we are still trying to get DCC to increase exit time from Rathdown.we hope to have an engineer from DCC on site in the next few weeks to witness problem at first hand.

Rathdown (generally) repairs to potholes, carriageways & footpaths..

Potholes have been temporally filled, general area will be reviewed this month when engineer visits the area.

Repairs to Westbourne Rd.....

Repairs underway.

Terenure Rd.,E. yellow box at Aldi. Full width of road...being considered.

AGM 2016

A very well attended AGM was held on 19th April. Supt.Pat Conlon advised that all categories of crime were down, burglaries by 30% & that Terenure was a very safe place to reside in.

Traffic.....as usual traffic was a hot topic...

A number of residents spoke angrily about the increase in volume of traffic especially at weekends. the overuse of Bushy Park as a recreational centre, village market, terenure rugby club, proposed development of the VEC grounds.

The increase in traffic of people attending these venues is a worry to a lot of residents.

Valuable Tips

Be aware of strangers loitering – they may be planning to commit crime most burglaries occur during the day. Do not open your door to strangers. Fit a door viewer and chain/limiter.

Do not give money to people selling lines - most are bogus Keep doors and windows locked, curtains drawn at night and alarms set.

If going away advise neighbour/friend to take in post, monitor alarm etc.

If an alarm goes off, phone the Gardai immediately Do not keep keys on hall tables – they can be stolen through the letterbox.

When gardening be mindful of thefts of tools or from your house through open doors.

Keep sheds, tools & ladders secure by using good chains and locks.

Bicycle theft is on the increase take photo & serial number. Bogus callers offering Homecare are in the area. please report any incidents to Garda.

Planning Applications

Planning activity recently has been quite slow and no new applications have been recorded in this association's area for the past two months.

Permission was granted last year for 29, mostly $2\frac{1}{2}$ storey houses at the **Presentation Convent Site** on Terenure Road West. The same decision refused permission for 22 apartments/duplexes. The developer appealed this decision and the appeal has been upheld.

Permission was granted for 2 houses and 28 flats on the site of the derelict house at **85 Templeogue Road.** This decision was appealed but An Bord Pleanála granted permission subject to a reduction by one flat.

An Bord Pleanála has refused permission for a bungalow in the back garden of **35 Rathdown Park**. Permission had been granted by the City Council and this decision was appealed by the owners of No. 33. We supported this appeal.

Vehicular access was refused at **23 Templeogue Rd.** after appeal.

The Enterprise Centre got permission for an additional window on the south side. An appeal against this decision was unsuccessful.

Permission was granted for an infill house at 57 Bushy Pk.Rd.

Permission was granted for a change of use to a restaurant at **3 Terenure Place.**

The mural on the wall of the Dublin School of Music at **Eaton Rd.** was granted permission.

VEC Grounds

There are plans being considered to develop all weather football pitches on these grounds. we will keep residents informed of any developments.

An application to extend the garage at 45 Rathdown Drive 3m.towards the road was refused.
